

GUITAR USAGE CONTRACT

In order to eliminate any instrument damage or problems in the classroom, the following rules for guitar usage in music class have been instituted:

- You will be assigned a guitar with a number that you will be responsible for during music class. Any damage done during your use may result in compensation for the repair or replacement of the guitar.
- No one is to switch or trade guitars at any time.
- Be sure that the guitar case matches the guitar number you were assigned and placed in the correct location (cabinet at the back of the Auditorium) at the end of each class.
- Be aware while transporting the guitar throughout the classroom and while in use; it should be handled carefully so that it is not dropped or bumped into classroom furniture or other guitars. When the guitar is not in use, it should be kept in the case or placed on your seat; it should never be leaned against the wall or a chair, or placed on the floor.
- No guitars will be allowed out of the classroom, unless otherwise discussed and arranged by Mr. Marsland.

Statement of Responsibility

I have read and understood the above classroom rules regarding the usage of the guitars. By signing this document, I have indicated that I will abide by these rules with the understanding that failure to do so may result in disciplinary measures being imposed that may include, but are not limited to, compensation for damages and/or loss of guitar privileges.
